

## Setup Windows Live Mail

**Mail Server Username:** yourname@yourdomain.com

**Incoming Mail Server:** mail.yourdomain.com

**Outgoing Mail Server:** mail.yourdomain.com (*server requires authentication*) **port 26**

**Supported Incoming Mail Protocols:** POP3, POP3S (SSL/TLS), IMAP, IMAPS (SSL/TLS)

**Supported Outgoing Mail Protocols:** SMTP, SMTPS (SSL/TLS)

**You may need this information later when configuring Live Mail.**

1. Go to *Mail* under *Shortcuts* in Windows Live Mail.
2. Click *Add an e-mail account* at the bottom of the list.
3. Type your e-mail address under *E-mail address:*.
4. Type your password under *Password:*.
5. Enter your name under *Display Name:*.
6. Your Login ID is the username in the paragraph from above.
7. Type your password if it asks you for a password.
8. Make sure that *Manually configure server settings for e-mail account.* is checked.
9. Click *Next*.
10. Make sure IMAP is selected under *My incoming mail server is a \_\_\_ server.*
11. Enter the incoming mail server name from above into the *Incoming Server* spot.
12. Type the outgoing mail server name from above in the *Outgoing Server* spot.
13. The paragraph below says that the server requires authentication. However some mail programs are a bit iffy on this. Go ahead and select "*My outgoing server requires authentication.*" You can always change it later.
14. The port is shown in the paragraph above. Enter it in "*Port:* under *Outgoing Server Information.*"
15. Click *Next*
16. Click *Finish*
17. Click *OK*

That should have correctly configured your Windows Live Mail program.
